Background

This Fall, Sloughhouse RCD has two scheduled vacancies on the Board. According to the Sloughhouse RCD Director Appointment Policy, SRCD notified the Board of Supervisors of an upcoming scheduled vacancy. Staff is now in the process of posting the scheduled vacancies and soliciting applications until September 30, 2026.

Applications will be reviewed and voted on at the October SRCD Board Meeting.

From the SRCD Director Appointment Policy: "After deliberating on the applicants, the Board may select from a variety of public processes to develop a draft recommendation and final recommendations must be approved by a majority public vote of the SRCD Board. Current SRCD Directors may vote for themselves if applying to be reappointed."

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Now Accepting Applications for Consideration of Appointment to the SRCD Board of Directors

At its regular October 2026 meeting, the current Board of Directors of the Sloughhouse Resource Conservation District will review applications for appointment to the Board and select two individuals to nominate to the Sacramento County Board of Supervisors in accordance with Public Resources Code section 9314 for two scheduled vacancies. Those appointed by the Sacramento County Board of Supervisors will serve a 4 year term on the Sloughhouse Resource Conservation District Board of Directors.

If you are interested in serving on the Board of Directors of the Sloughhouse Resource Conservation District, please complete this application and submit it to SRCD on, or before September 30, 2026 at 5:00pm. The Application may be submitted in person to SRCD Staff, mailed USPS, or emailed to the address below. The applicants are invited to appear personally at the District's October 2026 meeting.

Pursuant to Section 9352 of the California Public Resource Code, to qualify to serve as a SRCD Director, candidates must:

1. Be a registered voter in California.
2. Reside within the district.
 - a. A registered voter who is not a district resident can become a director if a resident landowner appoints them as their agent. A resident landowner must submit a statement assigning the director candidate as their agent for the purpose of serving on the SRCD board.
3. Meet one of the below requirements:
 - a. Own land in the district.
 - b. Have served as an associate director for two years.

You will be advised by the district board if you are selected for nomination and your appointment is confirmed. Thank you for your interest.
